The on-call number is available to provide assistance with handling crisis/emergency situations and to inform FCS staff of client behaviors and needs both after normal business hours and on weekends. The following is a list of events where foster parents need to call the FCS emergency on-call.

This is not an exhaustive list; when in doubt, page.

Missed medication dosage

Physical or Verbal aggression/altercation

Runaway/threat to runaway

Suspicion of inappropriate sexual behavior

Stolen property

Medical emergency (intrusive medical care **MUST NOT** be provided without paging and receiving locality CPS approval **FIRST**)

Substance abuse/Possession of substance

Disclosure of physical/sexual/verbal abuse

Threat/Attempt to harm others/self

Missed Biological Family Visit

Law enforcement involvement of any kind



If you feel your foster child is escalating, please call so together we might be able to prevent one of the above situations from occurring.
