The on-call number is available to provide assistance with handling crisis/emergency situations and to inform FCS staff of client behaviors and needs both after normal business hours and on weekends. The following is a list of events where foster parents need to call the FCS emergency on-call.

This is not an exhaustive list; when in doubt, page.

Missed medication dosage Physical or Verbal aggression/altercation Runaway/threat to runaway Suspicion of inappropriate sexual behavior Stolen property Medical emergency (intrusive medical care MUST NOT be provided without paging and receiving locality CPS approval FIRST) Substance abuse/Possession of substance Disclosure of physical/sexual/verbal abuse Threat/Attempt to harm others/self Missed Biological Family Visit

If you feel your foster child is escalating, please call so together we might be able to prevent one of the above situations from occurring.
